Code of Conduct & Helmet Contract Form

In order to participate on the OES Snowboarding Team, the student and his/her parents agree to the following:

Student Code of Conduct

Be on time: The bus leaves at its scheduled time and it will not wait for you.

Use/Sale of illegal substances: If a member of the team uses, sells, distributes, or possesses alcoholic beverages, narcotics, or other illegal substances during participation at any team event, the student will be expelled from the team.

Behavior/Language/Destruction of property: You may be suspended from the team if you display rude behavior (including abusive language, vandalism, or fighting) towards coaches, advisors, other team members, staff or parents during any team function. Expulsion can result from any repeat offense. Any student member expelled from the team will not be entitled to a refund of any fees paid to the team.

Failure to participate in training: You are expected to practice with the team in order to participate in competitions. Coaches will make exceptions for those who have jobs or other reasonable excuses as approved.

Transportation to/from Mt. Hood Meadows: OES does not allow students to drive to athletic competitions. The only alternative to school bus ride is riding on a personal vehicle of a parent, coach, or team volunteer. If students arrange for an alternate transportation, they need to notify a coach or a team volunteer who is riding the bus that day.

Helmet Contract

Helmets are required to be worn at all times while participating as a member of the team whenever a rider is strapped into his/her board, either riding for fun, practicing, or competing.

Students witnessed riding without a helmet strapped on their heads will not be allowed to compete or participate in team functions.

I agree with the above stipulations and realize that breaking any of the above Codes of Conduct or Helmet Contract may result in punishment as severe as expulsion from the team. I also agree to wear my helmet at all times during my participation as a team member while riding for fun, competing, and practicing.

I understand there are absolutely no exceptions to the helmet requirement.
